**Activity:** Private car to hike, bike (or mountain bike), or horseback ride on the Catskill Scenic Trail. This 19-mile trail lies on top of the former rail bed of the U&D Railroad and features a hard-packed surface with very gentle grades — an easy trek with beautiful scenery between Hobart and Grand Gorge.

**Date:** Wednesday, Aug. 4

**Time:** 9:30 am

**Where:** Bloomville-Stamford-Roxbury, Route 10-Route 23-Route 30. The trail runs along the West Branch of the Delaware River and NYS State Routes 10 and 23. It can be accessed at several points but the group will meet at a parking lot 8 miles east of Delhi on Rt. 10, just east of the village of Bloomville. The plan is to hike from one to four miles. The trail is marked with octagonal signs that show the distance to the trailhead in the direction you are facing. Directions will be printed in the reunion program or check out their website listed below.

**Price:** Trail is free. The closest bike rental location is at the Plattekill Bike Park, 469 Plattekill Mountain Road, Roxbury, NY. Phone: 607-326-3500. Bike rentals are \$30.00 per day; and, with notice, they will meet you anywhere on the trail with the bikes. They have about 35 bikes to rent for adults and children.

Horseback adventures can be had at the Stone Tavern Farm, 2080 Upper Meeker Hollow Road, Roxbury, NY, 12474. Phone: 607-326-3600. \$30.00 per person for one hour trail ride (must be 10 years or older), plus pony rides (4 years or older) is \$25.00 for 30 minutes. Strongly recommend 24-hour reservation notice.
